- 1 Develop & implement a sustainability strategy to achieve our mission and establish meaningful targets including carbon emissions reduction, Use resources efficiently to minimise energy use, water, waste, and travel and support innovative solutions to resource management and reuse rather than dispose whenever possible and promote recycling and the use of recycled materials.
- 1 Review our sustainability strategies, policies, and performance on a regular basis and make resources available for sustainability improvements and engagement with internal stakeholders and communications to external stakeholders.

- 1 Partner with organisations that practice sustainability and encourage knowledge exchange and be aware of British and International Standards to include the following:

EPD, (Environmental Product Declaration, or EPD, is a document which transparently communicates the environmental performance or impact of any product or material over its lifetime).

BREEAM, (BREEAM originated as a British certificate, meaning it is adapted to the British and European construction law and British best practices).

LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) is a rating system developed by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) to evaluate the environmental performance of a building and encourage market transformation towards sustainable design).
